Each club with 5 cars in attendance will be awarded a trophy. The cost is \$5.00 per car. Although we have not had any formal meetings, please try to attend and let me know if you can. Applications will be included with the questionnaire. Send them in as quickly as possible as the official registration date has expired.

We wish to extend a hardy welcome to a new member, Larry Chandler, who has offered to assist me in getting the Chapter active again.
